Nursing Now Madrid's 16 Objectives

- 1. Promote the leadership of nurses in political and health organisations.
- 2. Increase the number of assistant nurses in the public, and private healthcare system and in long term care.
- 3. Improve problem solving through recognition of nursing skills.
- 4. Unify all university healthcare graduates in the same professional group to end current inequalities that directly affect nurses.
- 5. Display the catalog of specialist nursing positions within Madrid's healthcare and education system, in relation to making the link to nursing specialties within the academic postgraduate sector.
- 6. Improve nurses' access to university teaching positions, developing and implementing combined clinical nurses and academic positions.
- 7. Encourage nursing research by increasing funding and focus on promoting research units.
- Standardise nursing care according to existing regulations and the available scientific evidence
- 9. Empower nurses in the design and implementation of technological tools.
- 10. Create spaces, led by nurses, for participation and promotion of health aimed at individuals, families and communities.
- 11. Improve the visibility of the nursing profession.
- 12. Promote the active participation of students in the future of nursing.
- 13. Develop effective protection plans for nurses which reduce the risk of violent attacks suffered in the healthcare profession.
- 14. Work in a coordinated way with all areas of the health sector in order to put an end to professional intrusion.
- 15. Encourage patients and nurses to work together to identify available health resources
- Develop relationships with the media to promote nursing.
